

- Substitutions of animals will be allowed up to entry closing deadline. Any substitutions made after this time will be subject to a \$20 substitution charge for each. These substitutions will be taken during the shows check in time only in the show office.
  
- Cancellations of entry and stall fees will not be refunded after closing date. The show committee will consider refunds due to unforeseen circumstances on a case by case basis.
  
- The show reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, or connected with, or incident to, the show. The show holds the right to amend or add to these rules as its judgment may determine. An exhibitor who violates any of the rules will forfeit all awards and will be subject to such penalty as the show may order.
  
- Each protest must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$50, which will be forfeited if protest is not sustained. Such protest must state plainly the cause of the complaint or appeal and must be delivered to the Management of the show immediately after the occasion for such protest. Any protest as to the eligibility on account of the age or breeding of animals must be filed with the management prior to the day on which they are to be judged.
  
- Interference with judges from any exhibitor, in any way, whether in person or by agent, or servants, interferes with the judges, or shows disrespect to them, or the show, the management may exclude him from current and future competition in the ring and may also withhold prizes that have been awarded.
  
- Louisiana Brahman Association shows are invitational shows and they hold the right to extend, withhold, or revoke an invitation to any exhibitor or contestant.
  
- Diseased Animals cannot enter the livestock show area or grounds. Management will refuse unloading privileges to animals showing signs and symptoms of disease or sickness.
